VMN Mission Statement:

The Virginia Master Naturalist program is a corps of well-informed volunteers who provide education, outreach, and service dedicated to the beneficial management of natural resources and natural areas within their communities for the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Examples to help determine eligibility of programs:

- . Knowledge or experience that would directly enhance the NNMN core curriculum would be eligible. (i.e., Fishes of North America would be eligible, Fishes of the Great Lakes would not.)
- . Going on a bird walk (or other nature walk) with a knowledgeable leader representing an organization with particular expertise in that area would be approved (i.e., Audubon, NNMN, Ornithologist professor, sponsor agencies.); going with your neighbor would not.
- . A Virginia Department of Wildlife Resources, (DWR) program on Wildlife Management or Camera Trapping would be approved; a DWR program on Field Dressing a Deer would not.
- . A Master Gardener program on Sustainable Pest Management or Creating Wildlife Habitat in Your Garden would be approved; How to Grow Giant Tomatoes would not.
